



# Loggers' Run Middle School

## Dress Code

We, at Loggers' Run Middle School, believe that students have a right to attend a safe and secure school where the focus is on high academic performance. We believe our standardized dress code will help promote a safe and wholesome learning environment for all students. The dress code is the responsibility of the student. If students do not adhere to the following guidelines, progressive discipline will be put in place.

<b>Tops/Shirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Shirts must have collars and sleeves. Undershirts, sheer shirts, or camisoles/tank tops should not be visible.</li> <li>● The only t-shirts allowed are school-sponsored t-shirts (LRMS sports/activities).</li> <li>● All shirts must fit properly. Shirts cannot be too short/tight. Skin should not be exposed at waistline/midriff, even with arms extended above head.</li> <li>● Shirts must not display any writing or graphics that refer to sex, drugs, violence, gangs, alcohol, tobacco, or other sensitive topics.</li> </ul>
<b>Pants and Shorts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All pants, including sweat pants and shorts, must fit properly at the waist, may have no rips, and may not sag or reveal undergarments.</li> <li>● Shorts, skorts, and skirts must be of appropriate length and coverage.</li> <li>● All form fitting pants, such as spandex, leggings, jeggings, or yoga pants must have appropriate coverage.</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All footwear must be closed toe and have backs. No slides, flip flops, slippers, sandals, Crocs, rubber thongs, cleats, or high heels will be allowed.</li> </ul>
<b>General</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Zipper-style or pullover hooded sweatshirts are permitted; however, students must wear Loggers' Run gear t-shirts or shirts that have collars and sleeves. Also, hoods cannot cover the child's head and face due to safety concerns.</li> <li>● No exposed undergarments, sports jerseys, see-through materials, or sleepwear is allowed.</li> <li>● No blankets are allowed.</li> <li>● No caps, hats, bandannas, or sunglasses are allowed.</li> <li>● Any attire, jewelry, or ornamentation deemed provocative, unsafe, inappropriate, or disruptive by the Administration Team is not allowed.</li> <li>● <u>School Board Policy 5.183 will be strictly enforced – all cell phones must be powered off and in a backpack during the school day.</u></li> </ul>
<b>Spirit Days</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Spirit Day attire will be approved by Administration.</li> <li>● If students choose not to participate in the Spirit Day attire, they are required to follow the school dress code.</li> </ul>
